**Robb College Women in Sport
Terms and Conditions**

Background

The Robb College Women in Sport Committee (WIS) established this sporting prize in 2023 to support a Robb sportswoman who, in their second year at College, has demonstrated great commitment to not only their team but their entire club, shows a great level of sportsmanship when playing and spectating and performs at a high level of sport whilst maintain a satisfactory academic record. The recipient must be returning to Robb for their 3rd Year of study.

This scholarship/prize will be funded by the Women in Sports Committee from donations from club members, sponsors and fundraising activities carried out by the Women in Sports Committee (WIS).

It is awarded by invitation only and after recommendation to the Committee. The recipient will be announced at the Robb College Sports Ball in Trimester 2 each year and the funds will be paid into the recipient’s Robb College residential fee account at 100% of the prize in Trimester 1 of the following year.

Residential requirement:	The recipient is required to reside in Robb College for the duration of the scholarship
Application Closing Date:	20 August each year.

Who is eligible?

1. The applicant is a current resident and intending to return to live in Robb College for their third year at UNE - see Conditions section of this document for specific living requirements of this scholarship
2. The applicant is registered or is intending to register to play netball or hockey with either Robb College Netball Club or Robb College Hockey Club, or is involved as a coach/sports administrator.
3. Application for this prize is by invitation only.

Selection Criteria (in Order of Importance)

The prize will be awarded on the basis of:

Playing experience/sports administrator resume and playing references

Then

Academic results (minimum Pass GPA must be achieved).

Notes

1. Preference may be given to applicants not in receipt of another scholarship.
2. The scholarship-prize shall be awarded on the recommendation of the WIS President and Head of College (or their nominees) and administered by the UNE Alumni Relations and Student Scholarships team.
3. The Selection Committee's decision is final.

Supporting Documents/ Required Information

1. The listed documents are acceptable forms of evidence in each of the following criteria:
 - a. Playing experience resume
 - b. Personal reference
 - c. Reference from a relevant person associated with WIS
 - d. Academic transcript from previous trimester

Conditions

General Conditions

1. Undergraduate scholarship holders may hold more than one Robb or other UNE scholarship (excluding the Betty Fyffe Scholarship) as long as the combined value is not greater than 100% of the total student's residential fees.

2. If you do not return to Robb College in the year of the award the Prize will lapse and the Committee may re-award the prize.
3. If you do not maintain and satisfy the criteria and conditions of the prize you will have to refund it.
4. The prize is payable into the recipient's residential fee account in one instalment within 30 days following the Trimester 1 census dates.

Notes

1. Full-time is defined at UNE as an enrolment of 8 units (48 credit points) in the academic year.
2. If this presents a problem the recipient must liaise with the Head of College to discuss their specific situation.

5. Receiving this Prize is subject to:
 - a. Achieving a Trimester GPA of at least 4.0 (Pass level).
 - b. The student continuing to enrol for full or part-time study on campus, residing in Robb College and continuing playing in a registered sport for Robb College.
 - c. Demonstration of appropriate sporting behavior on and off the field, i.e. the recipient should not bring the game, the Club or the College into disrepute.
 - d. The student abiding by the UNE residential behavioural codes and any registered sport player codes of conduct.
 - e. Maintain current player status with RCWIS, or, if injured, attend training and games if medically fit, and provide assistance to coaches as required.
6. Any request to vary the conditions of the prize must be made in writing to the Head of College and the Student Scholarships team and will be determined at their discretion (after consultation with other relevant committees).
7. If at any time during the prize term the student is found to have committed behavioural misconduct which results in a major penalty in accordance with the University's [Student Behavioural Misconduct Rules](#), or the [Residential College Code of Conduct](#) the prize will be terminated and any outstanding payments to be made under the prize will not be paid and you will be required to repay any instalment already received.
8. The student may be required to attend annual College dinner events if they are invited to do so, and may be asked to participate in activities to promote the College or WIS and other prizes/scholarships in general, including public speaking, donor liaison, media interviews and photographs.
9. Failure to meet the requirements of these Terms and Conditions may lead to the termination of the prize and you being required to repay any instalment received.

Scholarship Specific Conditions

1. The recipient is required to reside in and play or administer sport for Robb College at UNE for the term of the prize.

Acceptance

In accepting the **Robb College Women in Sports; “Emerging Sports Women Leader” Prize**, the recipient acknowledges that they have read, understand and accept the Terms and Conditions specified above.

Please note that this Terms and Conditions document must be signed and returned **IN FULL** no later than five (5) days from the date of offer email. You may contact the Alumni Relations and Student Scholarships team if you need an extension to this deadline.

Administrator Notes

1. Commencing September 2023 this prize is to be administered by the WIS in conjunction with the Robb College Foundation Association and awarded by the selection committee as outlined above.
2. This will enable tax-deductible donations to be raised by the Club and the RCFA from Alumni and friends of the Club and College.
3. It will remain a Donor-funded prize by the WIS via the RCFA each year until a sufficient corpus of endowed funds is raised within the RCFA Scholarship account to enable the award to be perpetual.
4. Individual Donor Tax receipts will be issued by the UNE Foundation. The funds in trust remain covered by the Donor Agreement 2014 established by the RCFA with the UNE and UNEF which ensures those funds can only be used for the benefit of residents of Robb College.
5. The required total annual prize amount is payable by the Robb College WIS Committee directly into the Robb College Foundation Scholarship account held within the UNEF Trust funds in one installment by the end of December each year. (Contact the RCFA Treasurer or Chair to confirm bank details).
