

TONY CARTWRIGHT MEMORIAL PRIZE

Commenced in 1973 this prize is awarded each year in memory of the late Mr G.A. (Tony) Cartwright, M.Rur.Sc. (U.N.E.), B.Ag.Sc. (Melb.), who was a senior tutor and member of the SCR of the College for five years from 1967 until his premature death in December 1972.

Tony was extremely popular with staff and students alike, a sympathetic and helpful mentor to many, a patient and efficient academic coach, an active and keen sportsman and a talented amateur actor and entertainer.

Tony was dedicated to Robb, an outstanding President of the University Cricket Club and a most popular Australian Football umpire. Tony also contributed to the administration of University sport in general by serving on the Sports Union's Executive Committee.

The Tony Cartwright Prize is awarded to the undergraduate member of the College with the highest academic achievement in the first year of an agriculture-related degree and returning to College.
